- ⇒ In light of COVID-19, the Red Cross has instituted new procedures to create a safe environment. Here are some changes:
 - * Temperatures will be taken of participants BEFORE entering the building
 - * Chairs at the canteen and beds will be kept 6 feet apart
 - * Both will be cleaned down after each use
 - * Red Cross staff will of course be using necessary safety gear (i.e. gloves, etc.)
 - * All canteen drinks and foods are prepackaged and provided by the Red Cross
 - * The Red Cross is starting to use a new software program for checking people in at the site. This will provide the opportunity to track individual's giving records. It uses a scanning device to scan either the individual's donor card or driver's license.
