

OSL CONFIRMATION OCTOBER PROJECTS

Choose **one** of the following projects to complete by the end of October. When you have completed the project check in with Pr. Sarah at one of your small group gatherings to talk about what you did and learned. If you have questions about any of the projects or how to complete them, contact Pr. Sarah.

1. Get to know **one** of the following people. Write a short paragraph describing what you learned or found interesting about their story and how their story connects to your life. OR create an artwork that depicts one of the major scenes in the life of your chosen character.
 - a. **Abraham and Sarah:** You can find their story here: Genesis 12:1-9; 15:1-6; 17:1-8; 17:15-22; 18:1-15; 21:1-7; 22:1-19; 23:1-2; 25:7-11
 - b. **Jacob:** you can find his story here: Genesis: 25:19-34; 27:1-46; 28:10-31:3; 32:3-33:17; 35:16-26; 49:29-33
 - c. **Joseph:** you can find his story here: Genesis: 30:22-24; 37:1-36; 39:1-46:7; 50:22-26; and Exodus 13:19
2. Go outdoors (in your yard, in a park, on a hike, etc.) and read one of the creation stories or creation psalms (Genesis 1:1-2:4a OR Genesis 2:4b- 23 OR Psalm 8 OR Psalm 104). Write a short reflection on your experience. How did reading the creation story/psalm out in nature change how you think about it. Include a short description of where you were – what could you see, what could you hear, was it warm or cold outside, etc.
3. Attend a Compline Service and volunteer to read one of the Scripture passages or one of the prayer petitions. Compline meets in-person in the parking lot at OSL at 5:30pm on Wednesday nights in October.
4. Volunteer to read the lesson for one of our Sunday morning worship service. Coordinate with Pastor Sarah or Pastor Heather.
5. Watch the bonus lesson on the Book of Numbers (posted in the Resource section).
6. Memorize the Ten Commandments. Be prepared to write them down or recite them. You can find a list of the commandments on page 1393 of your confirmation Bible (you only need to memorize the commandments and not Luther's explanations.)
7. Learn a couple of words in biblical Hebrew and biblical Greek. Set up a time to meet with Pastor Sarah.
