Choose **one** of the following projects to complete by Ash Wednesday (February 17th). When you have completed the project check in with Pr. Sarah at one of your small group gatherings to talk about what you did and learned. If you have questions about any of the projects or how to complete them, contact Pr. Sarah.

1. Volunteer to read the first lesson for one of our Sunday morning worship services. Coordinate with Pr. Sarah to record the lesson.
2. Memorize one of the Psalms. Be prepared to write it down or recite it. OR Write your own psalm. OR Create a piece of art based on one of the psalms
3. Jesus is both fully human and fully divine. List three aspects of Jesus' life/attributes of Jesus that point to his humanity. List three aspects of Jesus' life/attributes of Jesus that point to his divinity.
4. One of the events in Jesus' life is the transfiguration. Read the accounts of the transfiguration in all of the gospels. Find two things that are similar between the accounts and two things that are different. Contact Pr. Sarah for a side-by-side copy of the transfiguration story in all of the gospels.
5. Create an artwork based on one of the I AM statements from the Gospel according to John: I AM the bread of life; I AM the light of the world; I AM the gate/door; I AM the good shepherd; I AM the resurrection and the life; I AM the way and the truth and the life; I AM the vine.
6. Women were important members of the early church. Get to know one of these church mothers. Read her story and then write a short paragraph describing what you found interesting about her story or what questions you would like to ask her.

 - b. Lydia – Acts 16: 13-15
 - c. Priscilla Acts 18:1-4, 24-28
