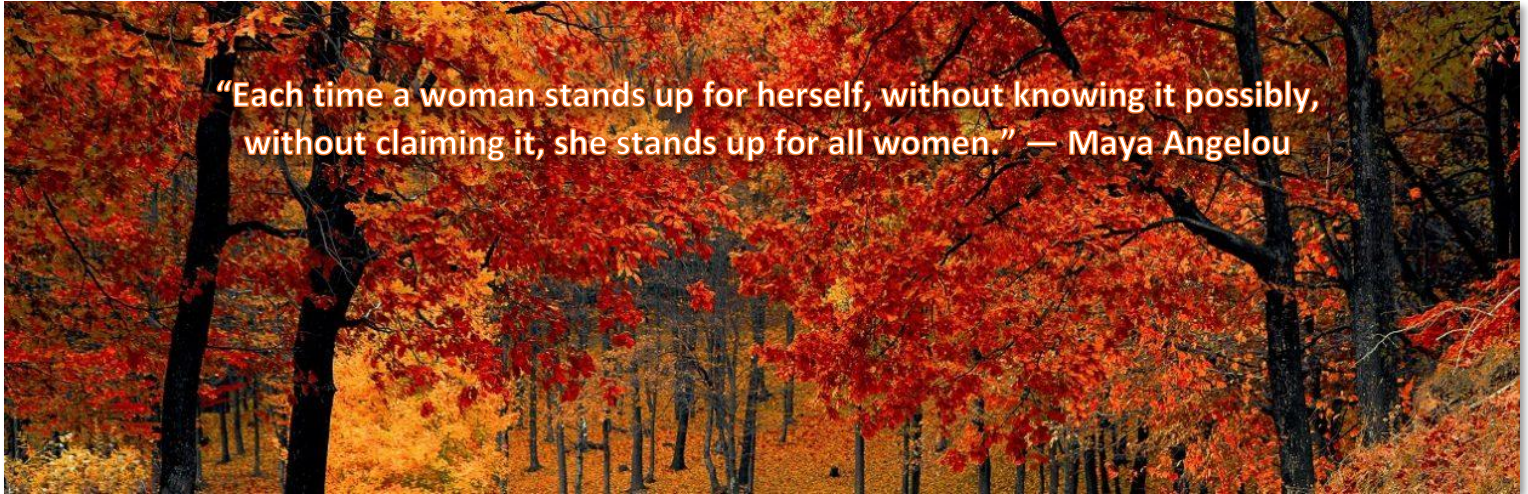

The Northwest Synod of Wisconsin [Lay School of Ministry](#) is seeking housing for Lay School students for next year's session beginning in September of 2026 and running through May of 2027.

Lay School meets in person the second weekend of the month at Our Saviour's Lutheran Church, 1300 Mansfield St., Chippewa Falls, WI. Years 1 and 2 will meet in person each month when possible. Zoom remains an option where distance or severe weather travel is an issue for participants. Continuing Ed meets via Zoom in the months when winter weather potentially makes travel hazardous.

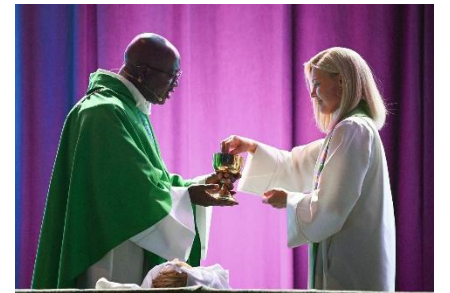

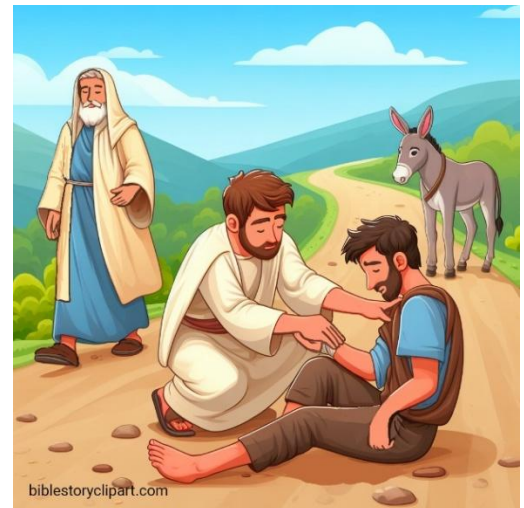
